PRAYER PROMPTS

JOIN US IN 21 DAYS OF FOCUSED PRAYER

STUDENTS

DAY 1: Pray for Christian students to be courageous in their witness for Christ, even in the face of opposition.

DAY 2: Pray for students from broken homes, abuse, or the foster care system to find safety and security in Christ.

DAY 3: Pray for students of other faiths (Muslim, Buddhist, Hindu, Mormon, etc.) to come to Christ.

DAY 4: Pray for students who are trapped in addictions, suicidal thoughts, the LGBT agenda, or considering abortions to turn to Christ and be set free.

DAY 5: Pray that students coming to Christ would lead to the salvation of their families.

SCHOOLS

DAY 6: Pray for many faculty and staff at schools to come to know Christ through the witness of students and teachers.

DAY 7: Pray that school administrators and staff would be supportive of Christian clubs and their outreach events.

DAY 8: Pray for protection against school shootings, violence, and harm.

DAY 9: Pray for Christian teachers to stand strong and be bold witnesses for Christ.

DAY 10: Pray that Christ's light would shine brightly in schools through gospel witness and outreach events.

CHURCHES

DAY 11: Pray for new partnership opportunities between churches and local schools.

DAY 12: Pray for pastors and leaders to have a burden to train students to bring the gospel to schools.

DAY 13: Pray that local churches will embrace new believers and disciple them well.

DAY 14: Pray for ongoing growth and maturity among church congregations, leading to more laborers for the harvest.

NATION

DAY 15: Pray that churches across the nation would exhibit repentance over sin and experience revival.

DAY 16: Pray that God would bring our country to repentance and an awakening to Christ.

DAY 17: Pray that God would appoint leaders on every level who make God-honoring decisions.
